Wheatfen Freshwater Group continue sampling Yare at Stoke Road , in Norwich. Last score 30th May 2024 = 12 = OK.

4th May Chris Bone visited two sites for NRT (Donna Dean). One at Great Ryburgh (Count = 8) and other at Woodnorton/Foulsham (Count = 11).

30th May Dan Hoare & Dennis Willis delivered a training workshop on site at Stoke Road, Lakenham. Four volunteers for the Lower Ouse Headwaters Project received certificates of successful completion. Seven live species of basic eight found and viewed (DW provided live sample of eighth). One offered possible 'occasional' support for a Norwich site.

15th August. Dennis Willis delivered training workshop at worthing fisheries. Blackwater site usedfor sampling. Four volunteers from Thetford Rivers group and two for Wensum catchment (Kevin Powell & Marc Jimson). Sites to be agreed shortly – provisionally hoping to resurrect Lyng and set up Ringland.
